1. Document whereby Decedent acquired ownership of real estate. This may include an Act of Sale, a Judgment of Possession for inherited property, etc.
2. Decedent's will, if applicable
3. Death Certificate
4. Certificate of Title or Registration for any items listed under "Vehicles"
5. Bank statement for each account for the period which includes, or is close to, the date of death of Decedent
6. Statements or bills from creditors for each account for the period which includes, or is close to, the date of death of Decedent.
